1. Call to Order (Irfan Al-Anbagi)

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

2. Acceptance of the meeting agenda

3. Acceptance of the previous minutes

Motion – To accept the previous minutes as circulated.

Carried. [Kin-Choong/Victor. All in favor]

4. Section Update (Irfan Al-Anbagi)

Irfan shared that he attended the Area West Chair's meeting (chaired by Bob Gill) and he had received a report that he will distribute it to all members. In essence, most sections have declining membership, and the big question is how to encourage participation/membership. Some of the suggestions were to give gifts to new and existing members. Irfan said that he showed our masks to them, and they were interested to use the same company to print the masks for their own sections. However, we cannot give money to members, only gifts. 9. Student activities update (Aditya Pathak)

Aditya reported that he attended a seminar from Ontario and they presented on "Why join IEEE?". Aditya felt that we could use that to attract more members.

10. Teacher In-Service Program (TISP) update (Victor Edoho)

Victor reported that he had no chance to schedule or do anything because of Covid-19. .

11. Computer Chapter update (Adam Tilson)

Adam reported that there were no updates.

12. Women in Engineering (WIE) update (Reagan Ong)

Reagan reported that there were some technical issues with the forming of the WIE affinity group, due to not enough WIE members. She managed to solve the problem and she finally got it submitted. Irfan remarked that we have to get it done before August.

13. Canadian Conference on Electrical and Computer Engineering (CCECE) update (Raman Paranjape)
